Trip Highlights

Join Rabbi Joel Mosbacher, Cantor Todd Kipnis and Temple Shaaray Tefila members for an amazing and powerful journey through the American South as we explore the Civil Rights Movement. The trip will start in Atlanta and travel across Alabama to the historic Civil Rights cities of Selma, Montgomery, and Birmingham. Highlights of the trip include meeting with speakers that marched and worked with Dr. King, crossing the Edmund Pettus Bridge, visiting the Equal Justice Initiative Museum and Memorial, and learning about Jewish Civil Rights Movement leaders. This trip is organized and led by Etgar 36.

Timing and Travel

The trip will begin in Atlanta on the evening of Thursday, May 2. **All participants are responsible for arranging their own flights to and from Atlanta**. We will not be arranging a group flight. Please book a flight with an arrival time at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport before 8:00 pm on Thursday, May 2. On Sunday, May 5, please book your return flight anytime after 3:30 pm.

Lodging

All participants will stay in hotels with double occupancy. For a single occupancy room, there is an additional fee of \$285. If registering as one person but would like double occupancy, you can submit the name of someone to share a room with on the registration form.

Who is Eligible to Participate?

Any Temple Shaaray Tefila member over the age of 26 is eligible to participate. Families must be current in all financial obligations to the synagogue unless arrangements have been made with Amy Schwach, Executive Director. NOTE: THIS TRIP IS STRICTLY LIMITED TO 48 PARTICIPANTS.

Costs and Registration

The full program costs \$1,300 per participant. The program cost includes all program expenses and activities, hotel accommodations with double occupancy, all meals from Friday breakfast through Sunday breakfast, tips and all local transportation during the trip. *This price does not include airfare*. For single occupancy, there is an additional charge of \$285. Your \$400 per person deposit can be submitted <u>via our registration form</u>. Full payment is due by February 15, 2024. This trip requires a minimum of 20 registered participants at the prices listed. All costs include administrative fees. Your spot is confirmed when your deposit is received. Spots are reserved on a first come, first to submit deposit basis, and registration will close once all 48 spots are filled.

Deadlines

Registration will close once all spots are filled. In the unlikely event that we do not reach capacity, registration will end on January 15th, 2024. Before February 1, all deposits are fully refundable. Final Payment is due February 15, 2024. Between February 14 and March 1, all but \$100 of your deposit is refundable. After March 1, no refunds will be possible.
